What is the Feast Day for Immaculate Conception CES?

The Immaculate Conception is a very special teaching in our Catholic faith. It means that Mary, the Mother of Jesus, was kept free from original sin from the very first moment she was conceived. God chose Mary to be the Mother of His Son and gave her a heart that was full of grace, so she could say “yes” when He asked her to become the Mother of Jesus. This reminds us of how much God loves us and how He prepares each of us for the special plans He has for our lives.

Having a school named Immaculate Conception is something to be proud of! It means that the school community is invited to follow Mary’s example by saying “yes” to God every day, in how we pray, how we treat others and how we choose kindness and love in our actions. Mary’s life teaches us to trust God, even when things are difficult, and to share God’s love with everyone we meet.

Each year, the staff, students and families of Immaculate Conception CES celebrate their Feast Day on September 28. On this special day, the school gathers for Mass and other activities to remember Mary and ask her to pray for them.
